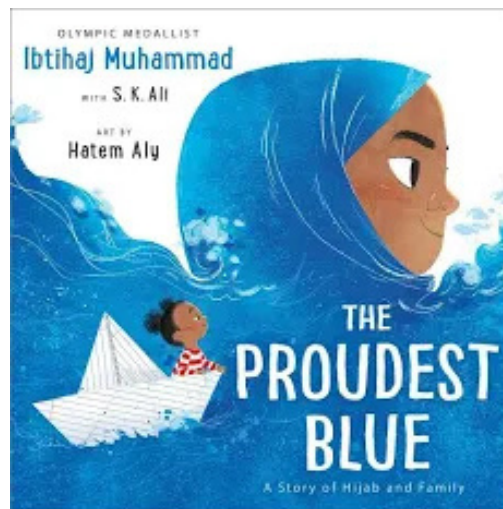

New Muscliff Resource Provision - Update

Last term we shared with you that we are working with BCP to create an Inclusion base (Resource Provision) to support children (across BCP) with SEMH (Social Emotional Mental Health) needs. In order to be ready to open this new provision in September we need to undertake some minor building works to adapt two of the classrooms and the community room. This work will begin on Monday. The area will be completely secure - fenced off on the outside, and internal temporary walls built inside, in order to ensure the health and safety of children, staff and workmen.

The Y1 children have moved to a new cloakroom/ toilets this week, and our current small group provisions have moved upstairs to the spare classroom. Breakfast Club and After School Club will use the Studio (near to the Reception base) from Monday. Drop off/ collection will be from the Reception gates. Thank you to the site team for getting the rooms cleared ready for next week. We look forward to sharing photos and updates with you over the coming weeks.

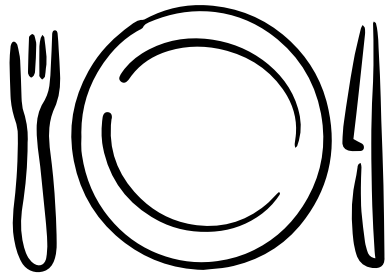

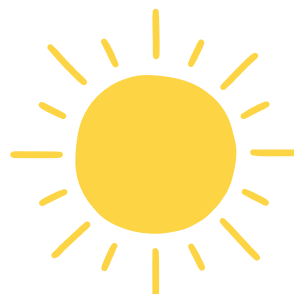
